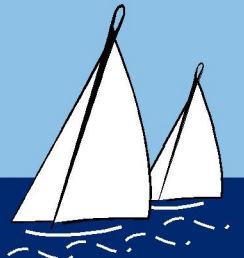

Minutes of LKN Quilters—June, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President, Jean Langdon. We had 31 members and six visitors at the meeting.

The program for the meeting was introduced by Rene Crowder. Cindy Williams of Franklin NC presented the program “Her Story” which was a biography of Cindy’s life as a quilter. And a preview of her Perfectly Pieced Borders Workshop to be held the next day.

Business Meeting:

The minutes from last meeting were presented and approved by verbal vote.

The Treasurer’s report was given at \$10,790.55 in the checking account.

UFO Challenge – given by Rene Crowder. A completion participation prize of a fat quarter bundle of fabrics was won by Snow Wildsmith. To be in the drawing for a participation prize, you must have completed at least one of your UFO’s during the previous month.

Block in a Box -- Reminder to members to pass one box a month to participants.

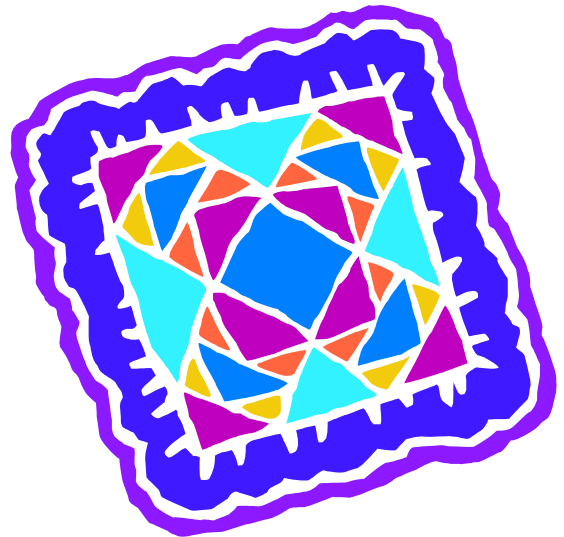
