

Time is ticking away, and if you are like me, I am entering that panic mode that happens before everything falls in to place. I am including a list of things needed for set up and take down. Because we will be under a dire time constraint, the more ladders we have the better. However, if we have ladders, we have to have Four people for each set of ladders: two on ladders and two on floor to thread the cross poles. We need: two stations for 9' ladders (8 people) and two stations for 6' ladders (8 people). If husbands are willing to volunteer to work ladders, we can do the floor work. So we need:

- 4 - 9' ladders
- 4 - 6' ladders

**Sheets:** At the next guild meeting, I will have the sheets divided. Please volunteer to take a stack. They need to be checked for cleanliness and ironed. You can bring them to the church when you bring your quilts to intake.

**Tickets:** I know you are all selling (or buying your tickets). If you have the money for your tickets, please bring to the July guild meeting.

**Volunteers:** This is a huge undertaking! We cannot make it without everyone pulling together. Our Guild is an amazing group and can accomplish anything if we all do our part. I know everyone cannot get on a ladder. I hope some husbands can help and I am going to solicit the help of some young men. Let me know if your husband (or if you feel ok on a ladder) can help. I need 8 ladder people for set up and take down.

Don't forget your items for the auction at the July meeting.
