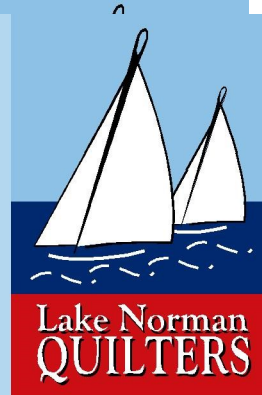


Sew it goes
