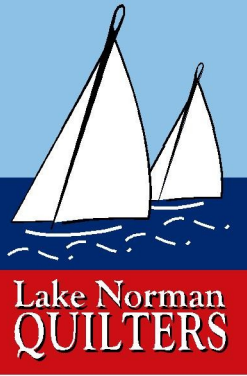

## LNQG Minutes—September 23, 2014

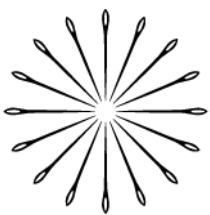
