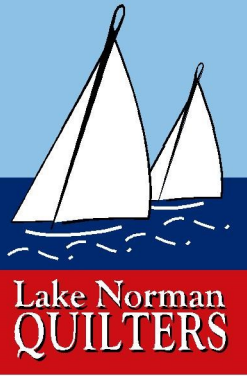

LNQ Minutes - August 25, 2015

The meeting was called to order by President, Jean Langdon. We had six visitors at tonight's meeting. As always, members are reminded to wear their name tags.

An overview of the quilt show was given:

Dolores Fobare reminded everyone to get all receipts to her from quilt show so they can be refunded and accounted for. She also presented rough financial estimates from the show:

Income: \$8,092.72

Expenses: 3,288.31

Approximate profit: \$4,804.41

Dolores Fobare presented The Treasurer's Report at \$14,122.17.

Please continue to sell the quilt raffle tickets.

Quilt Show chairs should updated their blue books and return to Judy Whitehead.

Requests were made to consider the position of 2017 Show chair and get ideas for the next raffle quilt.

Rene Crowder presented awards for the UFO challenge. 25 quilters participated, claiming 371 total UFO's and there were 132 finishes. Prizes were awarded for participating, finishing at least half, finishing the most, finishing all on their list, and for the most pieces in a quilt. UFO Challenge for the 2017 show will begin in January 2016, more details to follow.

Barbara Barrier announced the 2017 quilt show challenge: Yellow, Blue, and Green are the only colors allowed. Any size, any pattern.

Tickets were sold for the goodie basket and drawing was made. Jean Newman won the small basket and Laurie Feeney won the large.

Soup Kitchen donation was \$45.

Judy Whitehead reminded us that the Mystery Quilt will begin in September 2016.
