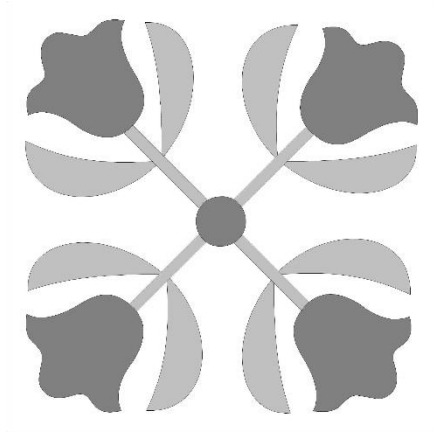

2015 – 2016 Mystery BOM

Month Five – January 2016

Our fifth block is an applique block titled “Tulip in North Carolina”. This will be a 12” finished block. (12-1/2” unfinished)



You will need to make one block for the quilt. You may use any method of applique that you prefer. I used a fusible version with straight stitching along the edges.

Your fabric choices this month are to use medium, medium light, and medium dark fabrics as show in the greyscale drawing.

The background fabric should be cut to 13” square to start. Then finding center by folding your fabric, lay out and applique your motif pieces in place. After all stitching has been done, trim the block to 12-1/2” (unfinished) size.

The dark lines on the templates are the edges of the applique piece, the dotted lines are seam allowances if you choose to do a turned edge applique. If you use a fusible, cut your pieces on the dark lines ignoring the dotted line seam allowance.
