# Meeting Minutes

## LNOG Minutes – December 15, 2020

The meeting was called to order by our President Jill Daly-Huston and was held as a Zoom meeting beginning at 7:00 p.m.

There were 16 members present.

Sandy Palmer advised that she was also a Member-at-Large with Rene' Crowder, so it has been determined after the meeting that it is not necessary to make any changes at this time (our Guild has two persons in this position normally). A big thank you to Kim Townsend for being willing to volunteer if it was needed, and for Sandy and Rene' for their willingness to continue in their positions!

A question came up about the location of the storage space rented by the Guild. Members were advised the space is located at AAA Storage at 1246 River Highway in Mooresville.

A reminder was made that dues can be paid now through the next couple of months and is \$20.00 for the year. Checks need to be made payable to Lake Norman Quilters Guild and mailed to Dolores Fobare at 644 Rebecca Jane Drive, Mooresville NC 28115. \*Please see the end of the minutes for an additional note regarding dues.

Members were reminded that Snow Wildsmith was the winner of the Paint Chip Challenge. Congratulations Snow!

The virtual sewing room/studio tours mentioned in the previous minutes were fun, and both Dolores Fobare and Marian Voorhees were gracious enough to show theirs. Both tours gave members ideas for making the best use of spaces as well as organizational ideas. Here's an overview of the tours:

- Dolores was able to repurpose her daughter's former bedroom, which is a 12' by 12' space. She has made good use of the space by incorporating a thread rack behind the door and organizing her fabric and supplies well. She also has made a scrapbooking corner in the room and an area for garment-making. She is a very creative person and can use her quilting space for other crafts, such as a homemade doll school room/boutique/hair salon/diner for her granddaughter that she is currently working on for Christmas that is simply amazing.
- Marian was fortunate enough (in her words) to be able to add a studio to her home which is large enough for her long-arm machine and all things "quilting." It has a 10' ceiling with high windows that allow her to have a design wall next to her fabric area but also help to keep the room bright. She is also able to have some large bookshelves for storage for the fabrics, batting, and other long-arm supplies. She has organized the studio with a sewing and ironing "triangle" so she can move quickly from one to the other, as well as a rolling cutting table. The room is large enough for a table for designing so she can customize her space for any project she is working on. It has sliding glass doors to allow for views of her yard and the lake which makes it a prime space for creativity.

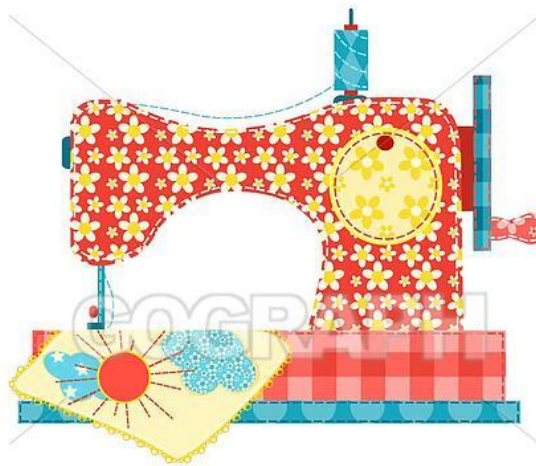
Show and Tell was held.

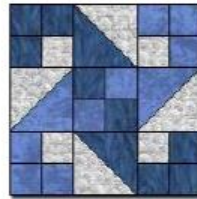

# Block of the Month

## WATERWHEEL VARIATION

This makes a 12" block!



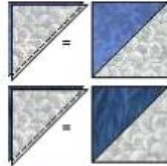
### \*\* Preparing the Pieces and Sewing the Block \*\*



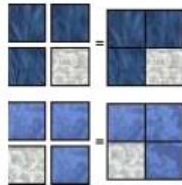
Referring to the supplies list, cut the strips and squares needed. Cut the Color 3 2-1/2" x 10" strip into four 2-1/2" squares. Cut the Colors 1 & 2 2-1/2" x 20" strips into eight 2-1/2" squares of each. Cut the Color 3 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip into two 4-7/8" squares...



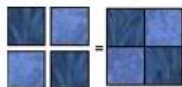
Now cut each of the Colors 1, 2 and 3 4-7/8" squares in half once on the diagonal to make half square triangles...



Sew the half square triangles right sides together to make two each of the units shown at left, using the standard 1/4" seam. Press seams towards the darker fabric. This should measure 4-1/2" ...



Sew the smaller squares together, again using a 1/4" seam, to make two of each of the four patch units shown at left, pressing seams towards the darker fabric. These should measure 4-1/2" ...



With the remaining small squares make the center four patch as shown at left. These should measure 4-1/2" ...



Then piece the block as shown at left. First make rows, and then piece the rows together, still using a scant 1/4" seam in each case. Press the seams of the top and bottom rows to the outside, and the seams of the center row to the center.

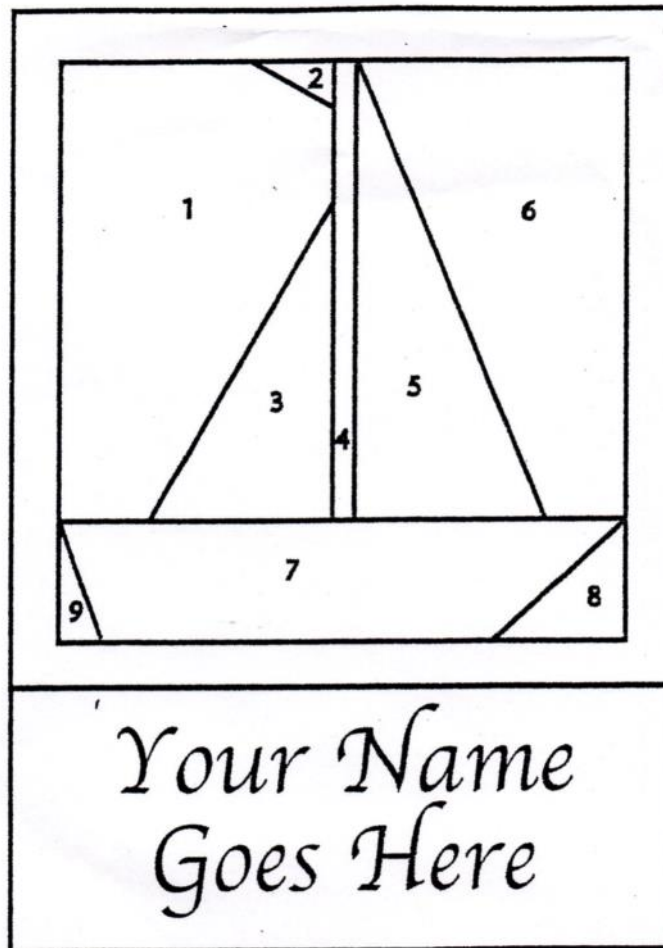
