

# Meeting Minutes

## LNQG Minutes – May 25, 2021

The members present decided to wait until another meeting to decide whether to sell or raffle these items, or keep them in the Guild for members to use.

Marian Voorhees presented the quilt to Donna made by members of the Guild as a going-away and appreciation present. Donna, who was the photographer and an active member of the Guild, will be truly missed.

Photographer – Kim Townsend volunteered to take over this position from Donna.

Newsletter – Judy Whitehead advised us that information for the newsletter should be sent to her by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month to be included prior to the next month's meeting.

This border should be added to the original center block by the next Guild meeting in June and presented then by participating members.

Patriotic Quilts – Cheryl Campbell reminded members that this project gives finished quilts to Veterans through Purple Heart Homes. During Labor Day last year, quilts were requested and 4 have been made so far. Members are encouraged to make a quilt to donate using 12 ½ inch blocks in a patriotic theme with stars. These can be given to Cheryl.

Judy Whitehead announced she will be closing her long-arm quilting business, Goneaway Quilting, on June 30<sup>th</sup>.

Greta McCrea brought the hexagon quilt she had been given and had first shown during the February Zoom meeting. The quilt needs to be finished using hand-quilting techniques as this is a hand-made quilt. Discussions will continue whether to donate this quilt when it is finished, and volunteers willing to help hand-quilt it are needed. Cheryl C. and Judy W. have quilt frames they are willing to loan for this project.

Congratulations were given to our member and past-president, Colleen Thrailkill, for her book that was recently published. The book is called “The Value of Rotting Pumpkins: The Art of Teaching Elementary School.” Great job Colleen!

Marian announced she has stack-n-whack blocks to give for Charity Quilts projects.

Our next presentation in June will be Linda Bryant to speak about a log cabin table runner project. The presentation will be at our regular meeting on June 22<sup>nd</sup>, with a workshop following the next morning at the church at 10:00 a.m. The workshop will be \$25.00, with sign-ups taking place now.

In October we will have an open sew day on a Saturday morning at 10 a.m. in the lower part of the church building. The cost will be \$10.00.

November’s program will be a repeat of the auction organized by Annette and Marian. For those that weren’t at the previous auction, Marian was the auctioneer and payment for items being auctioned were fat quarters brought by members. The more fat quarters brought, the more members had to bid with (although some got very creative and it turned out to be a very fun event).






